WELCOME BACK

We have started Term 4 smoothly and being a 10 week school term, it is going to go quickly. The last day for students in 2015 is Thursday 17th of December so make sure that date is in your calendar. ROSEWORTH AND PARENTS PROGRAM (RAPP)

We will be commencing the Roseworth and Parents Program in Week 3 this term and hope to see a great turn out from the families involved. The program will run over five weeks.

SWIMMING LESSONS: PP – YEAR 6 Classes

Our PP-Year 6 Classes will be doing their Swimming Lessons in Weeks 3 & 4 of this term. The lessons are to be at the Balga Pool and a bus has been booked for transport. The cost is \$55 and a number of students have paid this already which is great. Each student needs to return a completed permission note and an enrolment form, along with the \$55, to school as soon as possible so as we can finalise the arrangements. Forms are available from the front office if your child has lost the one given out last term.

ROSEWORTH CHILD AND PARENT CENTRE (CPC)

As you are aware, we have the Roseworth Child and Parent Centre onsite here at school. It helps give children the best possible start in life by improving access to a range of early learning, parenting, child and maternal health and well-being programs and services. The Centre provides support to families with young children aged from birth to eight years, through family-friendly facilities and programs and services to support parents, and help children develop and learn in their early years. If you have not popped into the Centre yet please do so. The staff there would love to see you. If you download their 'App' from the App Store you will be able to view the range of courses currently running or scheduled for the future.

SUMMER AND HATS

Please remind your children about the importance of wearing their school hat during the school days so that we minimise the effects of the sun during their play and outside lessons. Students should be wearing their school cap or hat at all times when outside during the school day. Students without hats are directed to play in areas of shade.

SWIMMING LESSONS ESC and PP - Yr 6

In-Term Swimming Lessons for the ESC Classes and PP – Yr 6 students will take place next term, beginning Monday 26th October and concluding Friday 6th November (Weeks 3 & 4). There will be a total of 10 lessons at the Balga Pool. The price is \$55 per child. The payment covers the cost of bus hire and pool entry. Payment may be made in a lump sum or in instalments by arrangement with the Registrar.

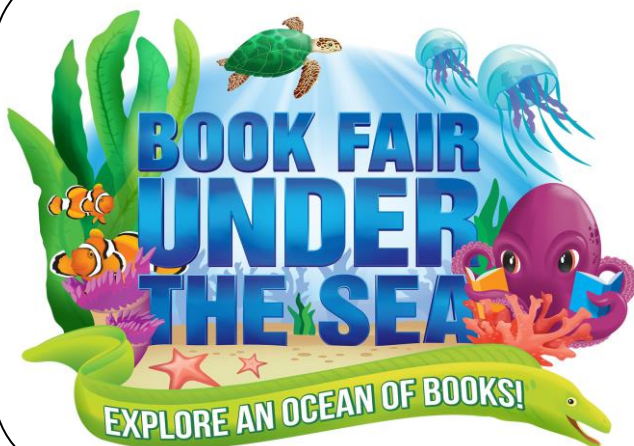

Due to a rise in the price of products the price for a lunch needs to be increased. Increases are not very common as Jane works hard to keep the prices as low as possible but sometimes they cannot be avoided. From Monday the 26th October the prices will increase from \$5.50 to \$6.00 for a lunch including a drink.
