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## **PASSPORT PROGRAM | IMPORTANT UPDATE | NEW PASSPORT ISSUED**

The Passport Program at Roseworth Primary School is designed to reward parents and caregivers for their contributions to school activities throughout the school year. For each activity that is attended, points are accumulated. Points can be redeemed to pay for:

Swimming Lessons, Uniforms, School fees, Canteen purchases and Incursions & Excursions.

A new Passport has now been issued for the remainder of the 2016 year. This new passport is designed to be significantly easier to use and to process for both parents and school staff.

### **What do I have to do?**

Simply drop off your existing Passport to the collection box in the Front Office as soon as possible. We will reissue your new 2016 Passport (complete with your points from your current passport) within 2 school days. All attendance points for 2016 will also be added to this new Passport. Once you have your Passport, simply request a green slip from your teacher upon completion of any listed activity.

## **SWIMMING LESSONS PP TO YEAR 6 AND ESC**

In-Term swimming lessons for the ESC Classes and PP – Year 6 students will take place next term, beginning Monday 24<sup>th</sup> October and concluding Friday 4<sup>th</sup> November (Weeks 3 & 4). There will be a total of 10 lessons at the Balga Pool. The price is \$55 per child. The payment covers the cost of bus hire and pool entry. Payment may be made in a lump sum or in instalments by arrangement with the Office.

It is essential that the enrolment and consent form is returned before the lessons commence so we are able to organise the correct number of swimming teachers.

Each child must have their own enrolment form/consent form to be handed to their own classroom teacher, regardless as to whom the payment is made.

The Roseworth Passport Program is up and running. The Passport Program is a voluntary reward program designed to promote and community involvement within the school and Roseworth P&C. Parents and community members are able to earn Passport Points by participating in selected activities; classroom helper, students attending 92% or better each term, attending parents/P&C meetings, payment of school fees and assisting with school & P&C events. These points can then be exchanged for Roseworth dollars which can be used to pay for lunches at the Canteen, school uniforms, school activities/excursions and fees.

## School Banking - Friday 8.30am in The Child and Parent Centre


