ROSEWORTH AND PARENTS PROGRAM (RAPP)

We will be commencing the Roseworth and Parents Program in Week 3 (Wednesday) this term and hope to see a great turn out from the families involved. The program will run over five weeks.

SWIMMING LESSONS: PP – YEAR 6 Classes

Our PP-Year 6 Classes will be doing their Swimming Lessons in Weeks 3 & 4 of this term. The lessons are to be at the Balga Pool and a bus has been booked for transport. The cost is \$55 and a number of students have paid this already which is great. Each student needs to

return a completed permission note and an enrolment form, along with the \$55, to school as soon as possible so as we can finalise the arrangements. Forms are available from the front office if your child has lost the one given out last term.

ROSEWORTH CHILD AND PARENT CENTRE (CPC)

As you are aware, we have the Roseworth Child and Parent Centre onsite here at school. It helps give children the best possible start in life by improving access to a range of early learning, parenting, child and maternal health and well-being programs and services. The Centre provides support to families with young children aged from birth to eight years, through family-friendly facilities and programs and services to support parents, and help children develop and learn in their early years. If you have not popped into the Centre yet please do so. The staff there would love to see you. If you download their 'App' from the App Store you will be able to view the range of courses currently running or scheduled for the future.

SUMMER AND HATS

At the end of the 2016 school year, the Year 6 students will move into the High School setting so this is an opportunity that will be valuable for our students. A series of transition sessions will be organised for groups of students in Term 4. Should you have not enrolled your child into High School yet, can I suggest that this be completed soon as the High Schools are currently finalising numbers and organising classes.
