STAFFING UPDATE

PP1 – Mrs Foreman will be commencing maternity leave this week and it is with delight that we thank her again for her efforts and wish her well for the impending birth of her second child. We expect we will see Mrs Foreman return through 2017.

E6 – Mrs Dale will also be commencing maternity leave later this term. We wish her well with the birth of her second child also and again expect to see her back in 2017.

We will notify the community about replacements for those taking leave as they are confirmed. It is anticipated that others will be taking leave for extended periods in the second half of the year. This will likely have an impact on the current structure of classes for Terms 3 and 4. The Administration of the school, in collaboration with staff, is examining how classes will be structured during Semester 2. This is in light of low class numbers and the school being able to optimise the programs offered. It will probably be that the school will need to drop one class and amalgamate students in other classes. If this is the case parents of students affected will be personally notified before the end of this term.

MARKET DAY STALLS – SISTER SCHOOL FUNDRAISER

We held our annual Market Day Stalls to raise money for our school and our Sister School in Cambodia today. A variety of stalls operated during the afternoon with each class organising one stall, along with a Café and Uniform Stall organised by the P&C. This event again was a huge success and was great fun for all the students, parents and friends that came along. **We would like to especially thank all the parents that volunteered and assisted on class stalls throughout the afternoon so as teachers were free to supervise their classes and tour the Market with their class.** Some of the fun that was had today included activities and goods in the form of a “CHUGGER Runner”, ‘Balloon Twister’, food stalls, a Bric-a-Brac stall, a Toy and Book stall, a Jewellery stall and a Playdough stall just to mention a few! The Market Day Stalls were held to raise money for both Roseworth PS and our Sister School in Cambodia.

NATURE PLAY AREA FOR KINDERGARTEN AND PRE PRIMARY

For those parents that have not visited the Early Childhood area recently, it would be worth a visit. We are establishing a ‘Nature Play’ area for the students of Kindy and Pre Primary. There is a wide range of factors which directly and indirectly influence children's healthy development. One consistent message from different fields of expertise is that spending time in natural environments enhances aspects of children's physical, sociological, social and psychological development. Children themselves prefer to play in natural environments and specifically trees and grassy spaces. Natural play settings provide more opportunities for both physical and creative play than built play settings. Children have a greater ability to concentrate after exposure to a natural setting than a built setting, regardless of the activity that has taken place.

This is the first stage of the project that will continue to see this area developed and more natural play environments at the school.

2017 KINDERGARTEN APPLICATIONS AND PRE PRIMARY ENROLMENTS

Kindergarten Enrolments - While it is not compulsory, almost all parents send their children to Kindergarten so they get the best start to learning at school. If you are applying to enrol your child in Kindergarten at Roseworth Primary School, this must be completed by **Friday 22nd July 2016**. Parents will be informed of the outcome of applications within three weeks of the closing date for enrolments.

Pre Primary Enrolments - If your child is currently enrolled in Kindergarten at Roseworth Primary School and you are not intending on returning for Pre Primary at Roseworth Primary School in 2017, can you please advise the Front Office.

In 2013 Pre Primary became compulsory and every child of Pre Primary age is required to attend school. All children in Pre Primary will be guaranteed places in their local schools. If you are applying to enrol your child at our school please contact the Front Office on 6240 4000.
