2018 KINDERGARTEN APPLICATIONS AND PRE PRIMARY ENROLMENTS

Kindergarten Enrolments - You need to apply to enrol your children in public school for 2018 if they are: starting Kindergarten – **4 years old by 30 June 2018**

While it is not compulsory, almost all parents send their children to Kindergarten so they

get the best start to learning at school. If you are applying to enrol your child in Kindergarten at Roseworth Primary School, this must be completed by **Friday 21st July 2017**. Parents will be informed of the outcome of applications within three weeks of the closing date for enrolments.

Pre Primary Enrolments - If your child is currently enrolled in Kindergarten at Roseworth Primary School and you are not intending on returning for Pre Primary at Roseworth Primary School in 2018, can you please advise the Front Office.

In 2013 Pre Primary became compulsory and every child of Pre Primary age is required to attend school. All children in Pre Primary will be guaranteed places in their local schools. If you are applying to enrol your child at our school please contact the Front Office on 6240 4000. All Application for Enrolments are now available at the Front Office

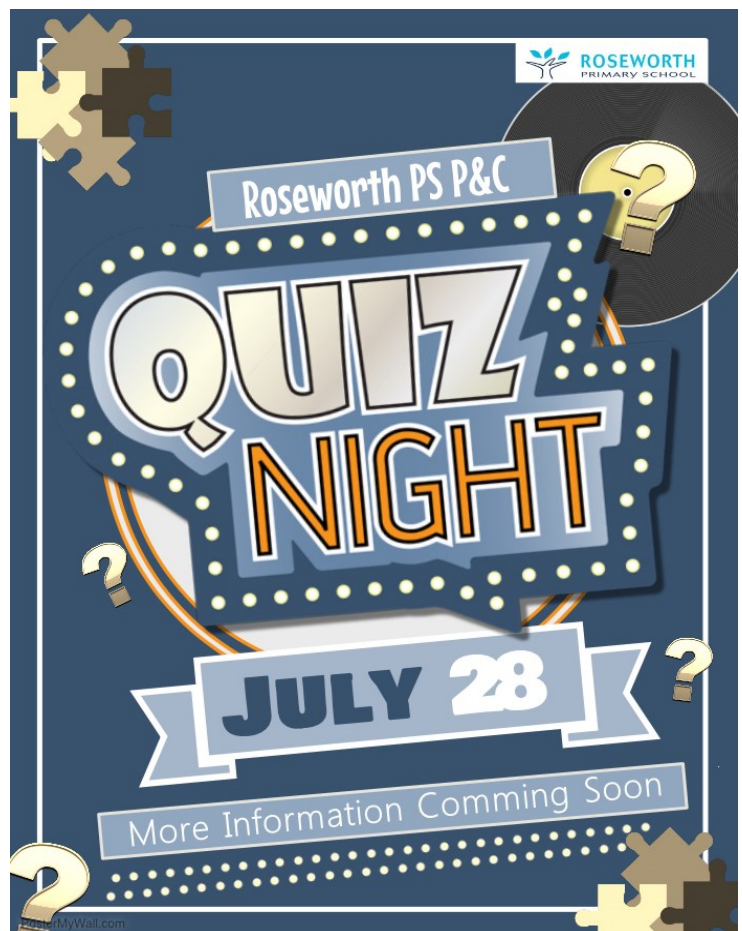
