Dear Parents and Carers,

It's mid Term Two and winter is almost upon us. Currently teachers are actively engaged in assessment and report writing for the end of semester formal reporting so we expect we will finish the term on a productive note.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Thank you to the parents who have already paid their child's \$30 Voluntary Contributions. Currently we have received 16% of Primary, 38% of Pre-primary and 41% of Kindergarten Voluntary Contributions. Overall this represents a lower percentage than this time last year and we would appreciate your support with this valuable contribution. These funds are used to purchase resources, library books and sporting equipment for student use.

PARKING CONCERNS

I have been asked recently about rules in regards to parking when dropping students to school and picking them up. This is often a difficult issue as there will never be enough bays provided by the local council and we have many students coming and going at the same time each day. The City of Wanneroo have jurisdiction over parking outside the School and as such regularly monitor the situation. They have produced a pamphlet in regards to the rules and I have attached this to the newsletter. I hope this provides some guidance about what you can do and what you can't and I ask that we all cooperate to make it safe for the students as they enter and leave our school each day.

2018 KINDERGARTEN APPLICATIONS AND PRE PRIMARY ENROLMENTS

Kindergarten Enrolments - You need to apply to enrol your children in public schools for 2018 if they are: starting Kindergarten – **4 years old by 30 June 2018**

While it is not compulsory, almost all parents send their children to Kindergarten so they get the best start to learning at school. If you are applying to enrol your child in Kindergarten at Roseworth Primary School, this must be completed by **Friday 21st July 2017**. Parents will be informed of the outcome of applications within three weeks of the closing date for enrolments.

Pre Primary Enrolments - If your child is currently enrolled in Kindergarten at Roseworth Primary School and you are not intending on returning for Pre Primary at Roseworth Primary School in 2018, can you please advise the Front Office.

In 2013 Pre Primary became compulsory and every child of Pre Primary age is required to attend school. All children in Pre Primary will be guaranteed a place in their local school. If you are applying to enrol your child at our school please contact the Front Office on 6240 4000. Application for Enrolments are now available at the Front Office.




