



Remote Learning Guidelines

Purpose

To ensure continuity of learning between school and home if there are potential school closures or factors that may impact on student learning.

Modes of Learning

In the event of a school closure, students will continue learning through:

- Online delivery via the SeeSaw application
- Paper-based printed materials
- A combination of both.

Additional online resources will be provided for parents/carers such as the use of DOE WA Learning at home website www.education.wa.edu.au/learning-at-home

Online booking and taking out of school library books via the school website.

Modes of Delivery

- Hard copies of learning packages covering 2 weeks of work will be available from the school for collection. A roster will be provided for families that will be communicated via text, Facebook and SeeSaw and will include families doing a drive/ walk through to pick up. During this collection, stationery and other equipment will be offered for families in need.
- RPS has surveyed families in relation to their technology capacity for online learning. All teachers have access to this information and will use SeeSaw to facilitate connection, help with student learning, collection of student work.
- Individualised learning for students with additional needs will include weekly phone contacts by teacher and/or Special Needs Education Assistants.

Resources

- Each teacher has selected appropriate SIDE materials for their classes for two weeks for English and Mathematics.
- Specialists have provided work to do for 2 weeks for Spanish, Art and Physical Education. The learning activities can all be done with household items (Equipment will be available on request).
- Values books are provided that are aligned to Aussie Optimism program and mindfulness, as part of the school's wellbeing programs.
- Extra reader books are available for families to take home as well as library books can be borrowed from online booking system.
- Resources provided are copyright compliant.

Teaching

- Teaching staff have been provided with an iPad, web camera and stylus. Videos will be provided to families from teachers to assist with students feeling connected to their teachers.
- All staff are familiar with webex and use of one drive to share resources and information. Collegial groups use Teams to communicate and all staff are familiar with SeeSaw and Connect Learning for access to resources.
- Teachers have been advised to complete *Preparing for distance Learning* online PL.

Admin

- Staff and student contact details are updated regularly and shared through one drive by admin team.
- Communication tools are all available remotely: MessageU (School Officer), Facebook (MCS) and SeeSaw (deputy, principal & MCS) and staff email groups (admin).
- DP has a student wellbeing team (chaplain, psychologist, AIEO, Ethnic EA) available on needs basis.
- Admin to conduct regular checks for staff wellbeing.
